Jewish Federation of Northern New Jersey is pleased to confirm the participation of your student in our exciting educational program, IsraelNow Northern New Jersey, taking place February 12-20, 2024. This program is a week-long, hands on Jewish educational experience designed specifically for eighth graders.
